

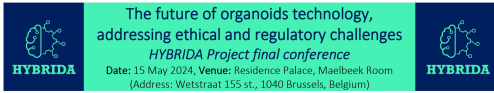
The Pontifical Academy for Life participates in the European HYBRIDA Project
